### ASSUMPTION

#### §195.1000 - Over-the-Counter Purchase of Ivermectin and Hydroxychloroquine Tablets

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, Department of Social Services, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Missouri Department of Conservation and Missouri Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
