ASSUMPTION

§§477.050 and 508.010 – Provisions Relating to Cole County Circuit Court

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator (OSCA)** state this proposal may have some impact but there is no way to quantify that amount currently.

Oversight notes OSCA assumes this proposal may have some impact on their organization although it can't be quantified at this time. As OSCA is unable to provide additional information regarding the potential impact, Oversight assumes the proposed legislation will have a \$0 or (Unknown) cost to the General Revenue Fund. For fiscal note purposes, Oversight also assumes the impact will be under \$250,000 annually. If this assumption is incorrect, this would alter the fiscal impact as presented in this fiscal note. If additional information is received, Oversight will review it to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek approval to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, various Cole County officials were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note. FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act modifies provisions relating to the circuit court of Cole County, including its appellate district and venue of certain cases.

APPELLATE DISTRICT FOR COLE COUNTY (§477.050)

This act provides that Cole County shall be within the territorial jurisdiction of the Eastern District of the Missouri Court of Appeals, rather than within the Western District.

VENUE FOR CONSTITUTIONAL CASES (§508.010)

This act provides that in all actions in which there is any count alleging a procedural defect in the enactment of a bill into law or the validity of a provision of the Missouri Constitution, a Missouri statute, or a Missouri regulation, the venue shall be in Cole County.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
