Bill Summary: This proposal requires the Governor to appoint a Board of Directors to oversee any statewide activities association that facilitates interscholastic activities for secondary school students.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§167.795 – Board of Directors to be Appointed by Governor to any Statewide Association for Secondary School Students

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** assume this proposal adds to the Governor's current load of appointment duties. Individually, additional requirements should not fiscally impact the Office of the Governor. However, the cumulative impact of additional appointment duties across all enacted legislation may require additional resources for the Office of the Governor.

Officials from the **High Point R-III School District** assume the proposal will have a fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes under this proposal, any statewide association that facilitates interscholastic activities for secondary school students shall be overseen by a board of directors appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. The term of office of each director shall be four years, with the initial appointments staggered such that two members shall serve terms of two years, and three members shall serve terms of four years. If the General Assembly is not in session when a position on the board of directors becomes vacant, the Governor shall make a temporary appointment. Therefore, Oversight does not anticipate a fiscal impact to school districts.

Officials from the **Office of the Lieutenant Governor, Missouri House of Representatives**, and **Missouri Senate** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above-mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
