2018 Spring and Fall Turkey Hunting Season Dates

Spring Youth Hunt: April 7 - 8

Regular Spring Turkey Season: April 16 - May 6

Fall Firearms Turkey Season: Oct. 1 - 31

2018-2019 Deer and Turkey Archery Hunting Dates

Archery Season: Sept. 15 - Nov. 9 and Nov. 21 - Jan. 15, 2019.

2018-2019 Firearms Deer Hunting Dates

Firearms Deer Early Youth Hunt: Oct. 27 - 28 Firearms Deer November Hunt: Nov. 10 - 20 Firearms Deer Late Youth Hunt: Nov. 23 - 25 Firearms Deer Antlerless Hunt: Nov. 30 - Dec. 2

Firearms Deer Alternative Methods Hunt: Dec. 22 - Jan. 1, 2019

HUNTER SAFETY COURSE INFORMATION

How do I get my MDC permit card?

1. Study and pass the online course.

Study and pass the \$15.00 course. Throughout the Missouri Hunter Education Course, you'll be tested on what you've learned.

2. Complete your age-dependent certification requirements.

If you are 16 years or older, after successfully completing the online course, you'll immediately print out your proof of online course completion.

If you are under 16 years of age, you'll immediately print out your proof of online course completion, which you will need to bring with you to the Hunter Education Skills Session. To sign up, go to www.mdc-event-web.s3licensing.com/Event/AllEvents?EventTypeId=1.

Remember: Passing the online course does not guarantee you a spot at the Hunter Education Skills Session.

3. Get your Conservation Permit Card.

If you are 16 years or older, your permanent Conservation Permit Card will be mailed to you by the Missouri Department of Conservation.

If you are under 16 years of age, you'll receive your permanent Conservation Permit Card after successfully completing the Hunter Education Skills Session.
