FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator**, the **Office of the Attorney General**, the **Office of Prosecution Services**, the **Office of the State Public Defender**, and the **Department of Public Safety – Missouri State Highway Patrol, Missouri Capitol Police, and Division of Fire Safety** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Oversight assumes the proposal would result in an increase in fine revenues for political subdivisions; however, the exact amount of increased revenue cannot be determined.
