FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

The **Department of Agriculture**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Office of Administration** and the **Office of the Attorney General** assume they would not be impacted by this proposal.

The **Department of Conservation (MDC)** assumes this proposed legislation would not have any direct fiscal impact on **MDC** funds; however, land acquisition by federal agencies, trades between state and federal agencies and conservation easements have relieved the state of expenditures.

**Oversight** assumes this proposed legislation would not result in the acquisition of land. Therefore, **Oversight** assumes there would be no fiscal impact on state funds as a result of this proposal.
