Officials from the **Office of Attorney General** assume the costs of the proposed legislation could be absorbed with existing resources.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact on small businesses would be expected due to this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation authorizes the Governor and the Board of Regents of Missouri Western State College to transfer land located in Buchanan County to the City of St. Joseph and the State Highway and Transportation Commission, respectively.

The substitute would authorize the Governor to bargain, sell and convey land located in Buchanan County which is currently part of the Department of Mental Health. It also specifies that consideration shall be negotiated by the Office of Administration and interested parties.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program, and would not
