This act excludes a properly displayed United States flag from regulation by state statute or city, town or village ordinance. A properly displayed flag is one that contains no additional design or embellishment and is flown or displayed consistent with the provisions of Title 4 U.S.C. Sections 1-10, pursuant to the normally accepted guidelines for display of the United States flag

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


