FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small businesses (cemetery operators) could receive interest income on the sale of pre-purchased services.

DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation creates a definition of "cemetery services". The proposal adds interment, entombment and inurnment cemetery services to the list of items that may be pre-purchased from a cemetery, subject to the cemetery owner meeting certain requirements regarding the deposit of funds from the sale of services into a segregated account and the use of funds in the segregated account. The proposal shall apply only to agreements for pre-purchased services entered into after August 28, 2002.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
