**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

ASSUMPTION

Officials from **The University of Missouri, Southwest Missouri State University, and Central Missouri State University**, assume no fiscal impact to their organizations.

Officials from the **Coordinating Board for Higher Education** assume this proposal would result in an unknown cost to the state General Revenue Fund for tuition and fee refunds, and for the publication of rules regarding refunds or incomplete grades to students called into military service.

**Oversight** assumes the number of additional students who would become eligible for tuition refunds or incomplete grades as a result of this proposal would be small, and the minimal related cost could be absorbed from existing resources.

This proposal would expand the eligibility criteria for allowing college students called into military service to qualify for tuition refunds and "incomplete" grades.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
